Practicum (JOUR 326) or internship (JOUR 491) is recommended every semester, starting the semester after COMM 105 or JOUR 205.

* JOUR 326, Stampede: Practicum. A minimum of four credits total is required; more is recommended; 1-2 credits per semester.

^ JOUR 491, Internship, may be taken during a regular semester or during a summer; a minimum of 3 credit total is required, but additional internship credit is encouraged.

+MATH 213, Statistics, is recommended but not required for journalism.

(m) Earning a minor in a complementary discipline is recommended for journalism.
